### Orientation

| Who is doing/being? naming word (noun/ pronoun) | What's happening? doing/being word (verb) | Where is it happening? (adverb group/phrase) |

### Complication

| Who is doing/being? | What's happening? | Where is it happening? | Where is it happening?         |
|---------------------|-------------------|------------------------|--------------------------------|
| Amy and her family  | moved             | a long, long way away  | to the other side of the world |
| Amy                 | is                | too far away           |                                |
| Amy                 | is                | half the world away    |                                |

### Resolution

| Who is doing/being? | What's happening? | Where is it happening? | Where is it happening?  |
|---------------------|-------------------|------------------------|---|
| His cry             | rang out          | across the yard        | across the street   |
|                     |                   | past the edge of town  | <i>across the ocean (shown in pictures only) the next page which is about Amy begins with 'Across the oceans' as a way of connecting the two children again. Only place where place is at beginning of the sentence – signals change – end of story</i> |
| Amy                 | woke              | across the ocean       | in a city with tall buildings   |
