ASSESSMENT RUBRIC: POETRY ABOUT PLACE

Productive mode

Students understand how the selection of a variety of language features can influence an audience. They create texts showing how language features and images from other texts can be combined for effect. Students create structured and coherent texts for a range of purposes and audiences. When creating and editing texts they demonstrate understanding of grammar, use a variety of more specialised vocabulary and accurate spelling and punctuation.
