

Task for *Mad Magpie*

Summary of story illustrations

The story	The clues
Magpie is angry.	Magpie fills the page with outstretched wings and tail, angry expression on his face and the large font of the word 'Attack!'
He's still angry (because he is being teased).	He still fills the page with an angry expression.
Other birds are talking to him/ giving him advice.	He is listening to the other birds and they are standing by the river.
The butcher birds are teasing him and he is still angry.	Open beaks of the butcher birds and Magpie still looks angry. The river is in the background and the large font 'Attack!' is repeated.
Cockatoos are giving Magpie advice.	Magpie is looking at, and listening to, the cockatoos. The river is in the background.
Magpie is still angry because the butcher birds are stealing the worms.	Worms are in the butcher birds' beaks and Magpie looks on with an angry expression.
The butcher birds are still teasing Magpie.	The butcher birds are following Magpie with their beaks open either taunting or laughing at him. The river is in the foreground.
Magpie begins to feel calm.	Magpie sees his reflection in the calm water of the river.
Magpie ignores the butcher birds and begins to sing. The butcher birds fly away.	Magpie is beside the river, his head is up and his beak is open. The sun is shining and the three birds are flying off in the distance.
The other birds come to congratulate Magpie as he continues to sing.	The sun is setting and Magpie has his head back and beak open.
At the end of the day Magpie feels proud of himself and the animal community is a happy place again.	Magpie is standing tall, his chest out. The moon is shining and birds are roosting in the tree. There's a ladybird on a reed.
All the birds are happy.	They look like they are dancing and singing.
