

## Task for *Reg Saunders: an Indigenous War Hero*

### A framework for researching the campaigns/battles

Questions to guide you in your research:	An example:
What was the name of the campaign or battle?	The campaign was known as The Battle for Greece.
When did the campaign or battle take place?	The campaign took place in April, 1941.
Where did the campaign or battle take place? Locate the place on a map.	The campaign took place in the eastern Mediterranean country of Greece.
Which armies were involved?	The Allied army (the British, Australian and New Zealand) helped the Greek army against the Germans and Italians.
Why did the campaign or battle take place?	The British wanted to stop the Germans and Italians from invading Greece.
How many soldiers were involved?	(680,000 German + 565,000 Italian soldiers)  <b>vs</b>  (430,000 Greek + 62,000 British Commonwealth soldiers)
What resources did they have?	The Germans were much better equipped with aircraft and armoured vehicles.
What was the outcome of the campaign or battle?	The Germans drove the British Commonwealth soldiers back to a port in southern Greece from where they were evacuated.
Why were Australian soldiers involved?	The Australians were part of the Allied army which also included British and New Zealand troops.
What happened afterwards?	The Allied soldiers were taken to the Greek island of Crete.
