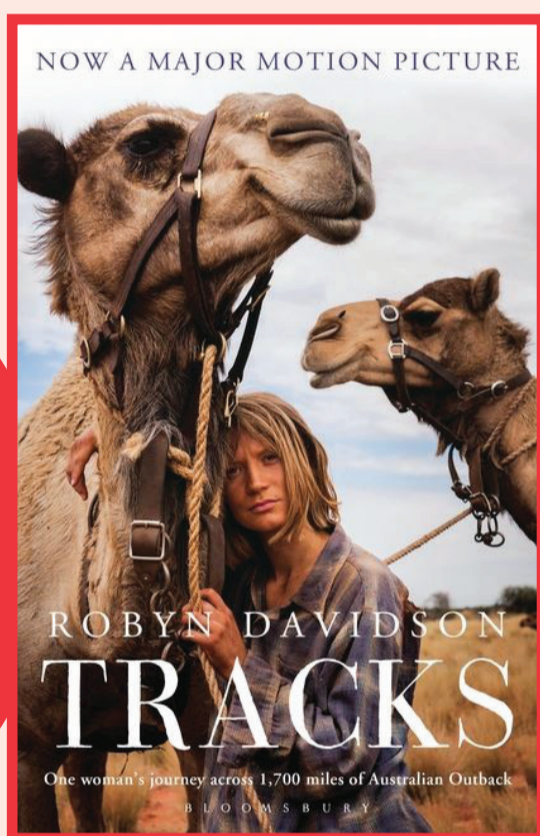


# Enter the Reading Australia Competition

Write a Haiku poem about your favourite **Reading Australia** book.

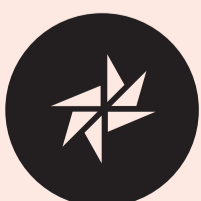
Haiku poems contain three lines. The first and last lines of a Haiku have five syllables and the middle line has seven syllables, just like our examples above.
