Synthesising Task: greed fable

Using your knowledge of fables, allegories and parables, write one of your own based on the following moral:

Nothing in nature is as cruel and savage as a greedy human being.

Consider the audience for your story as fables, allegories and parables may have different readerships.

Remember:

- Fables should include characters that are animals
- Allegories have characters that represent bigger ideas or concepts
- Parables use human characters

You may present your story in the following formats:

- Storyboard
- Comic strip
- Stop motion animation
- Video film clip
- Audiobook
- Podcast
- Newspaper article
- A collection of letters, postcards, diary entries, etc.

Make sure the moral of the story is very clear through the character's actions, the plot development, and the crisis point of the story.
