LITERATURE CIRCLE ROLES

Director 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Chair the reading session• Keep the reading and discussion on track• Make sure everyone gets to contribute• Use prompts, questions, and turn-taking to facilitate discussion
Connector 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• During reading, find and share connections within and beyond the text• Ask group members to say how these connections help them to understand the character, plot, or setting
Detective 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• During reading, identify important words or phrases and support the group to explain why they are important• During reading, identify unusual words or phrases and support the group to find out their meaning
Tracker 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• During reading, track the key information in the story• Record the information using a diagram• Ask group members to check, confirm, and contribute ideas
Summariser 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• During reading, jot down key ideas• After each chapter, read out the key ideas and ask the group to agree on the VIPs (very important points)• After reading, revisit the VIPs and expand, revise, or discard them• At the end of the reading session, agree on a final set of THREE TO FIVE VIPs
